It provides the guidelines and tools to analyze the current state of an enterprise in regard to IT governance and where it needs to be. The implementation road map consists of four phases each addressing a critical area of concern in the implementation process.

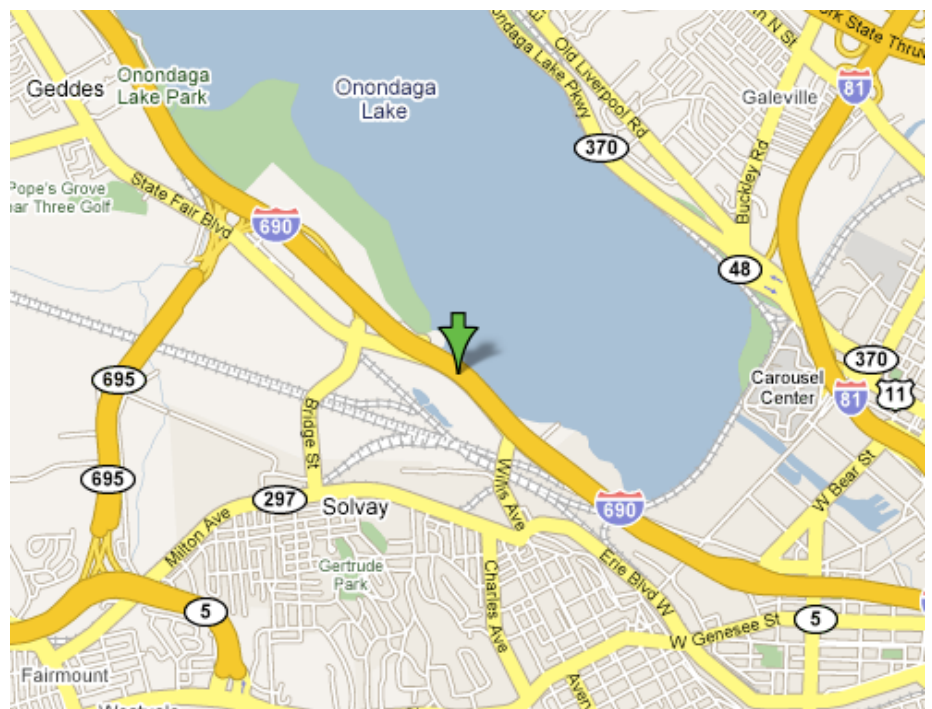
About the Speaker
