Directions to Wise Guys

From Route 690 Westbound

Take the West Street exit. Take the Erie Boulevard West exit. Turn left onto Franklin Street. After passing under Route 690, bear left to continue on North Franklin Street. Wise Guys is on the right.

From Route 81 Southbound

Take the Butternut Street Exit. Turn left onto North Franklin Street. Wise Guys is on the right.

From Route 81 Northbound

Take Route 690 West. Follow directions for Route 690 westbound.
